ADDITIONAL RULES FOR THIS EVENT:

1. Dressage Time will be available on Friday 27th August between 7-9pm ONLY on 01792 536643. They will also be posted on www.gowerridingclub.org.uk
2. All horses/ponies to be 4 years old or older, no horse/pony to enter more than one class.
3. A maximum of 30 entries will be accepted in each class on a first-come, first-served basis. A waiting list will then be kept. Please notify the organiser of any withdrawals asap – entry fee refunded only on production of a valid doctor's or vets certificate and at the discretion of the organisers.
4. Dressage test cannot be called. Correct tack and dress must be worn for each phase.
5. Body protectors to an approved BETA standard must be worn during the cross-country phase.
6. "L" fences may be used and an Optimum time may be applied.
7. Correct riding dress must be worn in the ring. All riders must wear hard hats when mounted with chin strap/harness on the GRC club field. We recommend hats to PAS015 or BS EN1384 or a superior standard. Hats marked ASTM are also acceptable. The former standards BS4472 and BS6473 are no longer considered adequate.
7. **NEW RULE: Medical armbands must be worn (can be purchased from the Club House).**
